### ORDER

1. University, vide paper read (1) above, invited applications for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2025 – 26 from the colleges for the courses affiliated to the University.
2. In response to the same, Principal, KMCT Ayurveda Medical College, Kozhikode, vide paper read (2) above, submitted their application with necessary documents and remitted required fee.
3. Subsequently, University carried out an inspection at the college to assess the facilities available for conducting BAMS course (60 seats) for the AY 2025–26 and the inspection commission submitted its report vide paper read (3) above.
4. The scrutiny committee verified the inspection report in detail and noticed that the infrastructure and clinical materials are sufficient but noticed the deficiency of a Higher faculty in Kriyashareera department.

5. As per the letter dated 03.04.2025 the deficiencies were communicated to the college



for rectification. In response to the same, the Principal submitted a compliance report dated 19.04.2025 and the same was examined by scrutiny committee held on 22.04.2025 and noted that the said deficiencies were not rectified.

6. Another letter dated 07.05.2025 was sent to the college for immediate rectification of deficiency. Upon the same, a compliance report with supporting documents was submitted by the Principal. It was scrutinized by the scrutiny committee on 22.05.2025 and found satisfactory. Thereby, scrutiny committee recommended to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to the college for conducting BAMS course (60 Seats) for the AY 2025-26.
7. The recommendation of the scrutiny committee to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation 2025-26 to KMCT Ayurveda Medical College, Kozhikode was placed before the Governing Council and vide decision read (7) above, the Governing Council resolved to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation 2025-26 to KMCT Ayurveda Medical College, Kozhikode for conducting BAMS course (60 Seats) for the AY 2025-26, subject to the receipt of Letter of Permission from the NCISM, Govt. of India, Ministry of AYUSH.
8. Vide paper read (8) above, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for the Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India has granted yearly permission to KMCT Ayurveda Medical College, Kozhikode with an intake capacity with 60 seats in UG(BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
9. Accordingly, orders are hereby issued granting Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to KMCT Ayurveda Medical College, Kozhikode for conducting UG (BAMS) course with 60 seats for the academic year 2025-26.
10. The college shall strictly adhere to the following conditions detailed below :-
  - The college shall comply with the conditions prescribed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, in the permission order granting permission to the college for conducting UG, BAMS course during 2025-26 vide letter read (8) above.
  - Selection, admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulation of the University / Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.
  - In the light of the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (C) 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the college will be initiated.
  - Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2025-26. The college has to apply for continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of letter of approval from the apex bodies concerned.
  - The College should remit balance annual administration fee fixed for UG ,BAMS course for the academic year 2025-26, if applicable.
  - Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
